Saturday September 24, 2016

What:

The Culver City Centennial Celebration will include a Parade, Opening Ceremonies and the Block Party of the Century. The Parade has over 70 entries and 1,000 participants from the community who will be parading along Culver Blvd. between 9:00 and 11:00am. Street closures will begin at 6:00am throughout the downtown area. Below is a list of the affected streets. At 11:00am the Opening Ceremonies will take place at the corner of Culver Blvd. and Main Street. Many local dignitaries along with invited guests will commemorate the city's first century. Following will be an afternoon of fun at the Block Party taking place from Noon to 4:00pm. This includes a Taste of Culver City and over two dozen performers vying for the Culver Cup voted on by the attendees.

Where:

The Parade will be staged on Overland Ave. between Braddock Dr. and Culver Blvd. The Parade route is on Culver Blvd. from Overland Ave. to Lafayette Pl.
The Block Party will take place on Culver Blvd., Washington Blvd., and Main St.

Street Closures:

Full closures: Culver Blvd. from Overland Ave. to Ince Blvd. Washington Blvd. at Duquesne Ave. Main St. from Venice Blvd. to Culver Blvd.

Local Access Closures: Residents are allowed to enter and exit the following streets between Culver Blvd. and Braddock Dr.: Keystone Ave., Mentone Ave., Le Bourget Ave., Motor Ave., Vinton Ave. Jasmine Ave., Jackson Ave., La Salle Ave., Madison Ave., Lincoln Ave., Duquesne Ave., Lafayette Pl., and Irving Pl.

Times:

The street closures between Overland Ave. and Duquesne Ave. caused by the Parade will reopen after 11:00am once the streets are determined to be safe by CCPD. The Block Party street closures from Duquesne Ave. to Ince Blvd. will reopen by 6:00pm once the streets are determined to be safe by CCPD.
